Developing Students' Social Skills through Scripting

Applicable to all students, but particularly students on the autism spectrum or with attention deficit disorder, social scripts help teach students how to interact with peers and adults, manage their anxiety, and address behaviors like aggression, fear, and obsessions Using social scripts is like practicing for a play, but the play is real life
